ORDER

The Appellees have filed a “Peremptory Exception of No Right of Action,” asserting that as original plaintiff Ludell Wafer died in June 2024, he is no longer a proper plaintiff and should be dismissed from the suit. Subsequently, Wafer’s surviving sister, Iriey Jean Wafer, filed a “Motion and Order to Substitute Party Plaintiff-Appellant” requesting that she be substituted as party plaintiff in place of her late brother. In compliance with U.R.C.A. 2-9 and La. C.C.P. art. 801, she provided documentation showing that on December 19, 2024, the trial court granted her petition to be appointed as administratrix to Wafer’s succession. Accordingly, the “Motion and Order to Substitute Party Plaintiff-Appellant” is hereby granted and Iriey Jean Wafer is ordered substituted as party plaintiff in this matter in place of Ludell Wafer. The “Peremptory Exception of No Right of Action” is denied as moot.
